

# Alexander, King of Jesters

## THEATER TECHNICAL RIDER

This performance is suitable for adults and children five and up. All children are requested to sit with their parents.

### TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **Performance Area:** A clean, broom swept stage that is a minimum of 12 X 18 feet. Height from stage to ceiling should be at least 11 feet. Please give notice if the ceiling is lower.
2. **Lighting:** A general, warm wash is required. Blackout capability is desirable. Alex has a separate list of lighting cues when a lighting technician is available.
3. **Sound:** Artist requires access to one (1) electrical outlet that is located in close proximity to the stage. If the outlet is not in close proximity to the stage, an extension chord of appropriate length must be provided. The presenter must provide a high quality house system with two inputs. Artist will provide one wireless microphone and an iPad for his music. If the show is local to Alex's home base, he can provide a sound system.
4. **Day of Show Schedule**
  - Arrival time: between 1 ½ and 3 ½ hours prior to performance (check with artist)
  - Lighting /Sound check: 1- 1/2 hours before performance
  - Length of Performance: 45- 60 minutes (no intermission)
  - Load-Out: 45 minutes after the show or signing of autographs

### AUTOGRAPHS & MERCHANDISE

The artist can be available after the performance to sign autographs. If an autograph signing is requested, the presenter must provide one table and one chair, located against a wall in the lobby.

The Artist also has DVD's and kazoos for sale. The presenter can earn a percentage of sales provided that the presenter announces the merchandise and handles transactions immediately before and after the show.

### HOSPITALITY

1. **Dressing Room:** Presenter shall provide a private, clean, well lit dressing room equipped with a mirror, chair, hangers, costume rack or hooks and soap, and in

close proximity to a private bathroom containing a toilet and a sink. *Note: a bathroom shared with any audience members is not acceptable*

2. **Meal** - Presenter shall provide light meal before the show consisting of a sandwich (turkey or roast beef, mustard, NO sesame seeds), baby carrots or other raw veggies, 2- 3 servings of fresh fruit, and orange juice
  
3. **Hotel Accommodations:** If hotel accommodations are being provided by the presenting organization, Alex requires one single, non-smoking room in a moderate hotel equipped with a mini-refrigerator and Internet access. It is preferable that the hotel be in close proximity to the theater.
