School Assembly Program Seating Plan
For *many* grades all present at one show

Occasionally, it is necessary to schedule a show with a wide range of grades in the audience. As we all know, sixth graders are still kids, but at a very different developmental level than first graders. The following seating plan addresses that on two fronts:

1. It integrates older and younger grades. Some of the older kids are rather close to the stage, and thus very engaged. They won't dismiss it as "stuff for little kids", a distinct possibility when ALL of the older kids are required to sit in the back.
2. It gives everyone a good sight line to the stage, so that younger (and on average, smaller) kids all sit in front of older students.
